2nd class OTC drugs

TŌKAIJYO

- ☆ TŌKAIJYO is a medicine consisting of 10 kinds of crude drugs. It has the function of gently lowering blood glucose.
- \$\frac{1}{2}\$ Improves various symptoms caused by diabetes (dry mouth, frequent urination, polyuria).
- ☆ This medicine is white sugar-coated tablet easy to take.

Precautions

Who should seek consultation

- 1. The following persons should consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered distributor before taking this medicine.
- (1)Persons undergoing medical treatment from a physician
- (2)Pregnant women and women suspected of being pregnant
- (3) Persons who have gastrointestinal weakness.
- (4)Elderly people
- (5) Persons with the following symptoms:
- edema, loss of appetite, nausea · vomiting
- (6) Persons diagnosed as having the following:

hypertension, heart disease, kidney disease

2. The following symptoms may be adverse reactions to this medication.

If any of these symptoms occur, stop taking this medicine immediately and consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered distributor. Take the instruction leaflet with you.

- 4. Stop taking this medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered distributor if symptoms do not improve after taking this medicine for about 1 month. Take the leaflet with you.
- 5. If you take this medicine regularly for a long period, consult a physician, pharmacist or registered distributor.

Magnesium stearate, Sodium copper chlorophyllin, Gum Arabic, Gelatin,

Saccharose, Calcium carbonate, Talc, Shellac, Hypromellose, Macrogol, Carnauba wax

Precautions for storage and handling

- ① Store in a cool, dry place free from direct sunlight.
- 2 Keep all medication out of reach of children.
- ③ Do not transfer the medicine to a different container.
 (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality of the drug.)
- ④ Close the bottle cap tightly after use to prevent deterioration of tablet quality from moisture. Do not touch this medicine with wet hands.
- ⑤ Discard a packing in a bottle after opening because it is used to prevent the damage of tablets during the transportation.
- 6 Fill in the "Opening date" of the box and bottle after opening.
- 7 Take this medicine as soon as possible to keep quality.
- 8 Do not take this medicine after the expiration date.
